




Emission spectrum



Radiant flux vs. pulse forward current





Pulse forward current vs. pulse forward voltage








- Light output vs. ambient temperature



→ Allowable forward current vs. ambient temperature





- Allowable forward current vs. duty ratio




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
Dimensional outlines (unit: mm)









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




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Recommended land pattern (unit: mm)

Time

- · After unpacking, store the device in an environment at a temperature range of 5 to 30 °C and a humidity of 60% or less, and perform reflow soldering within 168 hours.
- The effect that the product receives during reflow soldering varies depending on the circuit board and reflow oven that are used. Before actual reflow soldering, check for any problems by testing out the reflow soldering methods in advance.
